Uniform Guidelines

The HRA uniform standards include healthy grooming habits and good hygiene. All uniform items need to be clean, unstained, and fit properly.

General

- Backpacks, lunch bags, and other accessories shall be free of images or references to “pop-culture.”
 - No sunglasses, hats, or other head coverings inside, except appropriate head covering for ladies in the chapel.
 - No oversized or baggy clothing.
 - No tattoos, permanent or temporary, are permitted. This includes any pen or ink drawings on the skin.
 - No spray deodorants, colognes, or perfumes.
 - No headphones or earbuds on campus.
 - Hair may only be dyed a natural color.

Lower School and Upper School Gym

- Gym uniform is required on PE days and on other designated gym uniform days.
- Solid black nylon, polyester, or cotton athletic pants that are not form-fitting. (Pants may have a white stripe down the side, if solid black cannot be found. No visible logos are permitted).
- Official gray HRA t-shirt with logo, HRA Spirit Wear gray t-shirt, or HRA sport wear provided by the coach.
- Official HRA green quarter-zip, pullover sweatshirt, or HRA green Spirit Wear green sweatshirt.
- White, gray or black socks.
- A pair of indoor-only (non-marking) PE tennis shoes that should remain at school for use at indoor gym. Shoes must be a neutral colors, such as black,

Uniform Guidelines - Lower School (Grades K-6)



Lower School Girls

- Clean and combed hair, styled to remain out of the eyes.
- Hair accessories must be tasteful and complement the uniform (black, white, forest green, navy, or maroon). No headbands worn on the forehead.
- Solid white undergarments.
- White blouse with Peter Pan collar.
- Green cardigan sweater.
- Plaid jumper (length to the crease of the knee).
- White, navy, or black cotton dress socks (to cover the ankle bone) or tights.
- Black leggings may be worn in winter months under the skirt if there is no gap between the leggings and the sock.
- Crisscross tie.
- Sensible black closed-toe flat dress shoes (no ballet flats, Vans or Keds style shoes are permitted with the dress uniform).
- Hair may only be dyed a natural color.
- Jewelry limited to a watch around the wrist, one religious item around the neck, and one pair of small post earrings in each earlobe. Smart watches are not permitted.



Lower School Boys

- Have a professional haircut that is clean and neatly combed.
- Solid white undershirt.
- White, button-up dress shirt with turn down collar – No tuxedo shirts. Shirt must be worn tucked in.
- Black belt with undecorated silver or dark buckle.
- School tie.
- Black shoes that can be polished.
- Black dress socks (no low-cut or “no show” socks).
- Green V-neck sweater.
- Black or khaki-color uniform slacks with no patch pockets.
- Hair may only be dyed a natural color.
- Jewelry is limited to one item on the wrist and one religious item around the neck. Smart watches are not permitted.

Uniform Guidelines - Upper School Ladies (7-12)

Upper School Ladies

- Clean and combed hair, styled to remain out of the eyes.
- Hair may only be dyed a natural color.
- Hair accessories must be tasteful and complement the uniform (black, white, forest green, navy, or maroon). No headbands worn on the forehead.
- Solid white or nude undergarments.
- White blouse with square or pin collar, only top button may be undone.
- Navy V-neck sweater or navy cardigan from Schoolbelles.
- Plaid skirt (length to the crease of the knee).
- White, navy, or black cotton knee socks.
- One simple ring on each hand is permitted. One simple wrist bracelet on one wrist, and one watch are permitted. Smart watches are not permitted.
- One visible necklace, either plain or with a small pendant. The necklace chain should be delicate, metal, and in a single strand; only simple, fine-gauged, 16 to 20 inch, silver or gold chain necklaces are permitted. If a pendant is worn, it should be tasteful, appropriate, and small – religious medals and crosses are ideal – with no pendant to exceed ½ inch in length, width, or diameter.
- Black leggings, tights or nude nylons may be worn in winter (no low-cut or “no show” socks).
- Modest closed-toe black dress shoes (flats recommended with a maximum heel of 1 ½ inch height and minimum 1 inch width; no Keds or Vans style shoes with the dress uniform).
- One pair of short earrings on ear lobes only. Earrings may not hang more than ½ inch below the ear lobe, and loops are not to be larger than the size of a nickel.
- No ankle bracelets.
- Ladies in grades 9–12 may wear a modest amount of make-up applied tastefully. Heavily lined eyes, false eyelashes, or gaudy lipstick, glittered or white powdered faces will not be permitted.
- Ladies in grades 9–12 may wear clear nail polish or a French manicure. Nails should not be excessively long and should be a natural shape.

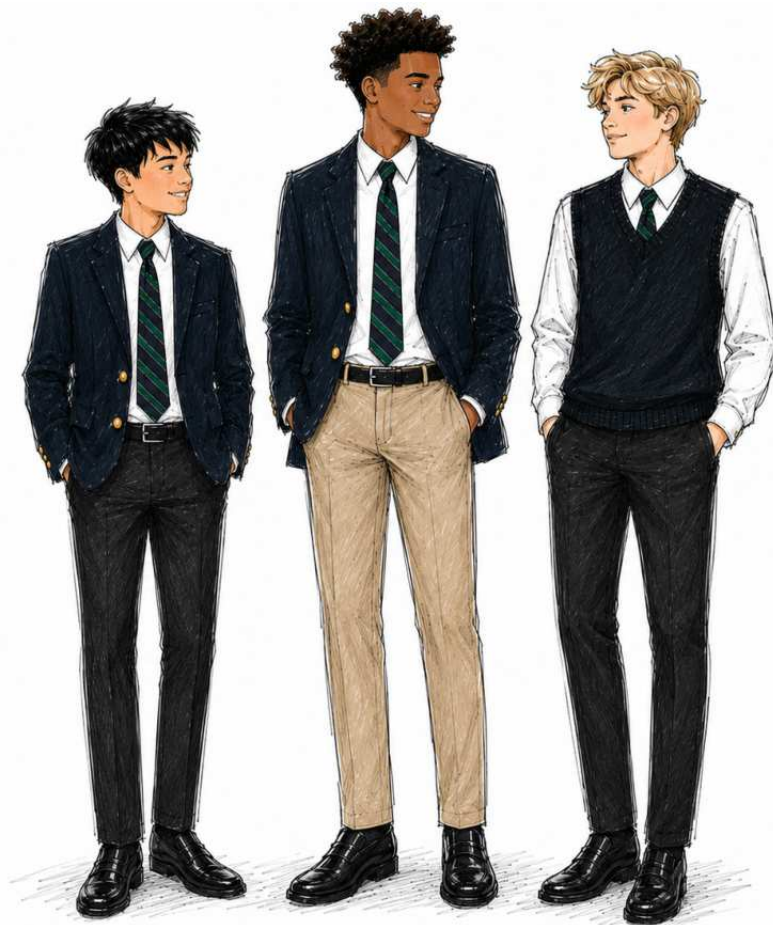

Uniform Guidelines - Upper School Gentlemen (7-12)

Upper School Gentlemen

- Have a professional haircut that is clean and neatly combed.
- Hair may only be dyed a natural color.
- Clean shaven.
- Sideburns only to the earlobe.
- Solid white undershirt.
- White, button-up dress shirt with turn down collar – No tuxedo shirts. Shirt must be worn tucked in.
- Navy V-neck sweater vest from Schoolbelles (optional).
- Navy blazer.
- Black or khaki uniform trousers with no external pockets.
- Black belt with undecorated silver or dark buckle.
- School tie.
- Black shoes that can be polished.
- Black dress socks (no low-cut or “no show” socks).
- No jewelry other than watches and religious items; limited to one on the wrist and one around the neck. Smart watches are not permitted.
